DEMEX was engaged by Fulton Hogan to demolish part of the sewerage treatment plant at Luggage Point, Pinkenba Queensland.

The Luggage Point Advanced Water Treatment Plant (LPAWTP) is part of the Western Corridor Recycled Water Project (WCRWP), one of the world's largest recycled water schemes and the largest project of its kind in the Southern Hemisphere.

The works involved detailed saw cutting and major structural demolition works around the delicate infrastructure. The project also included maintaining extremely low vibration limits, to ensure the infrastructure left behind was not disturbed. Because of this, vibration levels were closely monitored throughout the demolition process.

The client was extremely happy with the final outcome and we look forward to undertaking another project with Fulton Hogan in the near future.
