

MONARO HIGH SCHOOL, MITTAGANG ROAD, COOMA

DEMEX was contracted by St Hilliers to demolish 5 buildings and the strip out of a 6th building for the expansion of a new school in Cooma, NSW.

The buildings were be demolished over 5 stages which includes all surrounding pavement and landscaping to the area.

During Demolition works, unexpected finds of friable asbestos through many areas of the buildings which needed extensive remediation works prior to any mechanical demolition taking place.

These remediation works were conducted during school holidays and during school term which was conducted under extremely high safety constraints as determined by the NSW Government Work Health & Safety Act.

All works were to be undertaken whilst the school maintains operations requiring DEMEX and St Hilliers to work closely with all stakeholders to achieve an optimal result for all parties.

With COVID-19 travel restrictions were imposed, site personnel were permanently based in the local Cooma community to ensure the programme was completed without delay.
