DEMEX was engaged for the demolition of a pedestrian bridge in the busy Broadbeach shopping precinct adjacent to the Oasis Shopping Mall in Broadbeach, QLD.

open dialogue was maintained with the surrounding businesses to limit the disruption caused by the project.

CHALLENGES

The project included a four day closure of the area surrounding the pedestrian bridge. This was achieved in coordination with the local Gold Coast City Council, Queensland Police and WHSQ. DEMEX worked with an independent traffic control contractor to develop detailed traffic management plans, install permanent diversions around the area, and to ensure

DEMEX faced logistical challenges involved with bridge demolition in a heavy pedestrian and vehicle traffic zone, while also ensuring no damage occurred on the road below. Using the appropriate processes and control measures, DEMEX delivered the project safely without incurring damage to the surrounding assets and with minimal disruption to traffic and businesses.
