DEMEX was engaged by McNab Constructions to conduct civil and remediation work on a 5.13 hectare brownfield site following initial demolition works at Wollemi Place, Tweed Heads.

Ultimately, the bulk excavation cutting resulted in removal of 35,000 m³ of asbestos contaminated material from site into lined trucks for disposal.

Stage 1 demolition works were carried out during a period of mandatory COVID protocols and border closures, however, there was no disruption to the program.

Remediation of cut areas with legacy contaminated materials was covered with geofabric and capped with import of 33,823m³ clean CBR.

Stage 2 involved decontamination of the soil, dewatering and completion of bulk excavation work (cut and fill) to level the ground, during which DEMEX discovered asbestos contaminated soil.
